THE DAY FAMILY GENEALOGY AND HISTORY FROM EARLY SETTLEMENT TO PRESENT GENERATION

GEORGE DAY was one of the early settlers of Milford, Ct. and came with the Milford colony to Newark, N.J. in 1667. He married Mary, dau. of Edward Rigs(2) who with son Joseph came with the same colony to Newark. Edward Rigs(1) m. Elizabeth--- who d. at Roxbury, Mass. 1672. He had sons Edward(2) John, and 4 daughters. Edward (1) settled at Milford, Conn. 1646, Derby, Conn. 1654. Edward Rigs(2) m. Elizabeth Roosa in 1635, was an early settler at Derby & Milford. Had Ch. Joseph, Edward (3) and Mary, wife of George Day.

From the historical file of the Morristown Library

George & Mary (Riggs) Day had ch. ^{b. 1665} Paul, ^{b. 1667 Milford} George and ^{b. 1669 Milford} Samuel ^{d. 1714} ^{d. 1715}

He died before 1685, and his widow m. Anthony Oliff of Newark. Paul m. Phebe, dau. of Thomas Brown, d. abt. 1712. George had a 2d wife Phebe, in 1711, d. abt. 1720. Samuel m. Abigail ---- d. 1715 - had a son David and a post-humous son Samuel, b. At Newark, July 31, 1715. Removed Morristown abt. 1743.

Mary should have been a dau of one of these b 1712

Samuel (2) was referred to as Capt. Samuel Day in Morristown records 1760. He d. at Morristown of the prevailing epidemic-smallpox, Mar. 25, 1777. His wife Elizabeth, b. Dec. 1715, d. Apr. 22, 1761. M. 2d. wife Zeuriah or Zervia Wines, widow of Isiah Wines, who d. Oct. 3, 1751. She was b. 1720, m. Oct. 12, 1761, d. of fever Dec. 21, 1776. Conger's Newark Families has that he m. Abigail Carter. The Day records has wife Elizabeth, the Pres. Church Records at Morristown has wife Elizabeth received in Church, and three children bapt. Feb. 4, 1744, also death of Elizabeth and marriage of Zervia Wines, widow.

Item- Ezekiel Day's will bearing date 19 Dec. 1776, which I
have in my possession, gives beloved wife Joanna, certain
bonds and chattels, and provides for the benefit and educa-
tion of two children from the sale of real and personal estate.
"My son, John Day, two thirds and the other third I give to
my daughter Abigail, together with her own mothers cloths."
Item- I constitute my brother Jeduthan and my brother-in-law
Benjamin Lindsly, executors. Witness- Jonathan Wood, Nathaniel 24
Condict, Jehiel Day. Benj. Lindsly is mentioned in the church
records as brother of Col. Eleazer & Timothy. Records show
Mary, wife of Ezekiel Day, d. of consumption Jan. 12, 1774 -
ch. Phebe, bapt. Sept. 6, 1767, d. Jan. 1772; Elizabeth,
bapt. June 1, 1769; Abigail, b. Sept. 1, and bapt. Oct. 25,

No records of church give marriages of wife, or Joanna, or remarriage or death of Joanna. The items of Jeduthan Day, Exr. show a contrast from present charges. Inventory of personal 291 L 17 s. 4d. Sale of house and lot, 398 L. Paid John Thornburn for making coffin, 10 s. Paid Nathan Arnold for digging grave, 10 s.
